- Over 250 Stanmore students (90% of applicants) started university in October 2007

#### **A levels:**

- 99.8% A level pass rate in 2007 (in the past 3 years only 2 fails out of 1480 entries)
- 49 % A-B grades at A level in 2007
- Best average points per A level entry in Harrow state sector for second year running (DCSF league tables)
- One of less than 5 FE colleges in the country appearing in the Financial Times top 1000 schools, which is dominated by independent and selective schools
- AS pass rate at 94% was significantly higher than the national average and local state schools
- Advanced level success rate higher than national sixth form college benchmark
- A level added value is described as outstanding by the ALPs measure and 'statistically exceptional' by the ALIS measure for 3 of the last 4 years

#### **Advanced Vocationals:**

- At BTEC National Diploma level there was a 99% pass rate.
- All of the IT practitioners gained one of the two highest possible grades out of seven pass grades – as last year.
- All but one of the Business students gained one of the two highest grades, with over two thirds gaining the triple distinction (= 3\*A @ AL).
- The BTEC National Certificate pass rate was 98% – with 76% gaining one of the top two grades.
- There was a 100% pass rate again for BTEC Awards – equivalent to one A level.
- There was a 97% pass rate in the Childcare Diploma

#### **Intermediate Level:**

- The Learning Plus report placed Stanmore College first for level 2 added value across London and Berkshire in 2006 and second in 2007.
